Election Year Legislative Report Candidate Survey 2010

This report will identify the candidates for the upcoming November 2, 2010 elections. The formatting is easily readable. If information is not given it is due to either the Candidate did not respond to the questionnaire, the candidate did not return calls or refused to answer questions. This means that it is up to you, as their constituent, to get in contact with the candidate/s and voice your concerns. BikePAC is available to help but cannot be expected to be able to answer your questions or concerns that are beyond our abilities without your help.

For your ease of reading, we will be using a simple system for grading. You will see how a candidate listed below as an example and the notations explained. The system will utilize the following grades: ie...Andy Olson = S*

N = Not satisfactory - Does not support motorcycle issues. Has either a proven voting record against motorcycling or voiced opposition to our issues. Not a friend.

U = Unknown - The candidate either did not respond to phone calls, visits, etc or was unreachable for whatever reason. This means that BikePAC does not know what their stand is regarding motorcycle legislation. Neither friend nor foe. This means that you, as their constituent, need to contact them and report your findings to BikePAC of Oregon.

S = Satisfactory - The candidate either has shown support for our issues in the past or has answered our questions stating support for our issues. Friendly to our cause. If the "S" has a * after it, this means that this person has a proven record of support and has the support of BikePAC.

As in all elections, the decision about whom to vote for is one that only you, the voter, can make. BikePAC of Oregon does not endorse any candidate. We do, however, support certain candidates with different forms of support based upon our abilities and their needs. Remember that an "S" supports us, a "U" means unknown but we can possibly influence them to see our side, an "N" means that they do NOT support us.
